CFS is seeking motivated state certified teachers to implement individualized one-to-one supplemental educational services to students in their homes, communities, schools and/or other locations conducive to learning. This is a part-time position and all services must be rendered outside of normal school hours. Under the leadership of the Director of Community-Based Services, certified teachers will be responsible for providing evidence-based educational services in accordance to Child and Family Solutions guidelines and in compliance with State Standards.

Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited university in education or a related field.
- Valid teaching certificate from the State of Maryland.
- Experience providing educational instruction to students attending Title I schools and/or Special Education preferred.
- Must be able to work independently, have excellent communication skills and have an outgoing, motivated and self-starter attitude.
- Must be technologically savvy and demonstrate proficiency in Microsoft Word, PowerPoint and Excel.
- Must be highly organized and have the ability to set and maintain consistent appointments with students on your appointed caseload.
- Candidates must have a valid driver's license and availability for travel to student homes, schools and other community settings conducive for learning.
- Must be available to render services during weekend and after school hours.

Duties

- Work directly under the supervision of the Director of Community Based Services to implement both short- and long-term goals according to CFS's mission, policies and service philosophy.
- Provide individualized one-on-one supplemental education to students in the home, school and/or other community settings conducive to learning (outside of school hours).
- Document each session with a progress note and track progress through agency provided software.
- Attend peer supervision, monthly ISP meetings and professional development trainings as needed.
