

## **Description**

Intensive in Community (IIC) services provide clinical one-to-one interventions to a child or adolescent at home, school (if necessary according to treatment plan), or other community-based settings. The goals of services are: to stabilize the youth in his/her environment, prevent out of home placement, and allow the youth to remain in the least restrictive setting. Specific interventions/supports include but are not limited to the use of: cognitive behavioral strategies, family systems counseling, providing emotional support to the child and his/her family and assists the parents in developing skills necessary to stabilize youth and promote ongoing progressions when services are no longer in place.

The IIC will receive administrative supervision from the program director as needed. Clinical supervision from the regional team leader is mandated at one hour per 40 hours worked or one hour a month whichever is greater. The IIC will develop and implement treatment plans as well as communicate and provide direction to bachelor's level staff on the case.

### Minimum requirements

1. Master's degree in psychology, social work or related field
2. New Jersey Clinical Licensure, LCSW or LPC required
3. 2 years of relevant direct service experience.
4. Experience working with youth experiencing behavioral and/or emotional challenges strongly preferred.
5. Previous experience working with confidential information
6. Demonstrates strong technological skills strongly encouraged.

### Tasks and responsibilities include:

- Model and implement treatment interventions as documented in the treatment plan.
- Communicate and support case managers, bachelors level staff, school personnel, and family's efforts to stabilize the child or adolescent.
- Develop progress notes: rating progress and describing each client contact and how that contact relates to treatment goals.
- Collaborate with other members of the treatment team and other professionals working in the home, or in other community settings, and participate in Inter-agency/team meetings when necessary.
- Attend supervision and participate in professional development necessary to maintain State Licensure requirements.

**This is part time, fee for service position.** It is preferred that BA's maintain caseloads of at least 5 referrals. Each referral is generally authorized for two hours per week.
